



# CHANGE WE CAN BELIEVE IN

35 MPG

- Transportation CO<sub>2</sub> is over 410 million metric tons higher than 1990 levels
- Only way to reduce levels for cars is fuel economy
- 35 mpg standards will save 9 billion gallons of fuel and reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 8 million metric tons over life of vehicle
- Average 15 mpg car gives off 12.2 tons CO<sub>2</sub> vs average 30 mpg car gives off 6.2 tons

# CAFE Fails

- America based on liberty—the freedom to CHOOSE
- Plenty of fuel efficient choices available already
- Others desire larger, or more powerful options
- CAFE forces lifestyle change

- CAFÉ does not affect 247 million current vehicles
- Cars only 48 % of vehicle fleet
- Does not encourage public transit

- Vehicles designed years in advance, 2012 models developed already
- Lighter materials more costly
- Factories must be modified
